HOW TO CARE FOR TUBES:

- NEVER use alcohol, peroxide, or swimmer's ear in ears with tubes
- If you see drainage from an ear (any color), begin drops given after surgery. You were given 5 refills.
 - 1. Insert 3 drops, three times a day, for three days (3-3-3)
 - 2. Turn the head to the side that is draining and pull up on the ear.
 - Insert 3-4 drops into the ear and press several times in front of the ear to help drops get down into the ear canal.
 - 4. Then, place a Kleenex at the opening of the ear and turn the head over and let the drop out.
 - 5. If the ear is still draining after the third day, continue the drops and call our office.
- Bathtub water is dirty water. You may pour water over the head or take a shower, but no submerging in the water. If this should happen by accident, begin your drops as instructed above.
- Lakes, rivers, and streams are also considered dirty water and a plug should be used in the ear.
 You can purchase silicone plugs at Academy and roll and shape them like a sno-cone with pointed end into the ear.
- If you have a pool at your home that is salt water and Chlorine that is kept clean with chemicals that is safe for tubes. However, if you travel to a hotel, resort, or water park a plug should be used.
- Beaches located in Alabama and east are considered ok to swim in without a plug. Ex: Gulf
 Shores, Destin, Panama City.
